# Authorisation table (scary stuff)

## Policies for Item 2292/17719 (ID=22547)

With this editor you can view and alter the policies of an item, plus alter policies of individual item components: bundles and bitstreams. Briefly, an ADD/REMOVE/READ/WRITE policies, while bitstreams only have READ/WRITE policies.

You will notice an extra bundle and bitstream for each item containing the license text for the item.

# Access rights curation tasks

The curation tasks do the following:

- Update authorisation policy
- Create and update metadata



# Some examples of policies

- Freely available online
- Available to campus users only in Universities
- Available to administrators or discrete groups
- A mixture within an item of some parts being available and others restricted
- A mixture of different access for metadata and the associated bitstreams



# Case Study - PhD Digital Thesis @UoA

- The default access option of digital PhD theses is Open Access at the University of Auckland
- Students are the copyright holder of their theses
- Students sometimes request to restrict access to
  - part of their theses, and/or
  - the supplementary materials
- So, is there an easy way to restrict access to the files that cannot be made open, mostly because of copyright restrictions or requested by the copyright holder?
