## Simon O'Neill

New Zealander Simon O'Neill has established himself as one of the finest helden-tenors on the international stage. He has frequently performed with the Metropolitan Opera, at the Royal Opera House in Covent Garden, in Berlin, Hamburg and Bayerische Staatsopern, Teatro alla Scala and the Bayreuth, Salzburg, Edinburgh and at BBC Proms Festivals.

In 2016 Simon was awarded Doctor of Music (Honoris Causa) from Victoria University of Wellington. He became an Officer of New Zealand Order of Merit in the 2017 Queen's Birthday Honours list.

## **Karen Grylls**

Karen Grylls, ONZM, is Undergraduate Advisor and Associate Professor in Conducting and Head of Choral Studies at the University of Auckland. She has directed the Auckland Dorian Choir (1985-1998), assumed the position of Musical Director of TOWER NZ Youth Choir in 1989 and founded TOWER Voices NZ in March 1998. In addition to being the Artistic Director of Choirs Aotearoa NZ and current Musical Director Voices NZ, Karen also conducts the Chamber Choir at the University of Auckland and directs courses in choral ensemble skills.
